The Wediko School is a licensed year-round residential school located on a 450-acre waterfront campus in southern New Hampshire that provides therapeutic and educational services to boys aged 6 to 21 with emotional, behavioral, and academic needs. Most boys are between the ages of 10 and 18. We serve 38 residential students and 9 day students.

Wediko is committed to returning each student to his home, school, and community as soon as possible. Therapeutic treatment is maximized by building collaborative relationships with each student's family, school, and referring agencies. Through family therapy, Wediko helps ensure that skills learned at Wediko can be translated home. Wediko's skills-based, experiential educational curriculum and therapeutic milieu builds competencies, captures successes, and restores hope in children and families struggling with pervasive histories of failure, frustration, and fractured attempts at success.
