**Residential Counselors, Special Education Assistant Teachers, Certified Teachers, Assistant
Clinical Supervisors, Clinical Supervisors**

JOB DESCRIPTIONS: All staff work in a residential, psycho-educational treatment program, serving children and adolescents, ages 6-21, with serious emotional and behavioral disabilities (SED). The program is located in Southern New Hampshire.

Residential Counselors: Work as part of a team of 4-6 adults. Each team is responsible for a group of 8-10 children or adolescents with SED. (B.A./ B.S. in related field preferred)

Special Education Assistant Teachers: Assist lead teachers in planning and implementing active, learner-centered language arts, math and science curricula. (B.A./ B.S. in related field preferred)

Certified Teachers: Plan and implement active, learner-centered language arts, math and science curricula. (B.A./ B.S. and Special Ed. Teacher Certification required)

Assistant Clinical Supervisors / Lead Staff: Assist clinical supervisor in supervising therapeutic teams. Assist to provide treatment planning, crisis intervention, produce child clinical reports and supervise direct care staff. (masters or 2-5 years experience)

Clinical Supervisors: Supervise clinical group. Provide treatment planning, crisis intervention, produce child clinical reports and supervise residential staff team. (MA Required)

Supervision and training are provided throughout the program by clinical psychologists, social workers, special education professionals, therapeutic recreation specialists and licensed nurses. All staff participate in specific weekly training and weekly group supervisions.

QUALIFICATIONS: College graduates with a B.A./ B.S. degree in related fields, 21 years of age, and who have the ability to meet the physical demands of a rugged 450-acre setting. Previous experience with children or adolescents is helpful.

JOB DATES: 12-month commitment. Applications are accepted year round.

APPLICATION DEADLINES: Hiring decisions are made on a rolling basis. Send your materials as soon as possible. For an application contact Dennis Calcutt (see below). Interviews will be conducted once your application materials are received.

BENEFITS: Competitive salaries, health and dental, and life insurance, as well as a retirement program available. Housing, 6 weeks of vacation per year, tuition reimbursement, and a \$4700 AmeriCorps Education Award if eligible.
